RONALD E. HARVEY

September 18, 1941 - August 16, 2006



For Ron Harvey, retired Chairman of the Board of Directors of Huntington Area Postal Federal Credit Union, love of the employees and membership came naturally.

Mr. Harvey, who was involved in a number of civic groups, died Wednesday, August 16, 2006 after a short illness. He was 64.

Mr. Harvey was born September 18, 1941, the son of Dorothy Wilkes Harvey and the late Harold Harvey. He was retired from the United States Postal Service after 30 years of service. Ron served on our Credit Committee from 1987 to 1993 and was elected to the board in 1994 where he served as Chairman from June 2005 to April 2006.

“He went to work and worked very hard,” said Janet Sowder, CEO. “He was very generous with his time for civic and charitable organizations.”

He was a charter member of Sanctuary of Grace. He was also a member of IOOF, Charity Rebekah Lodge #39 of Huntington, Proctorville Masonic Lodge #550 F&AM, Teresa Chapter #257 OES of Proctorville and 32nd Degree Scottish Rite Mason, Valley of Cincinnati.

In addition to his mother, Ron is survived by his wife, Dreama Harvey; brother and sister-in-law Donald and Connie Harvey; his children and their spouses Doreen and Mike Gissel, Ronnie Harvey, Melanie Harvey, Gail and Wes Harbour and Kenny Blankenship II; grandchildren Codey Harvey, Evan Gissel, Ryder Frederick, Faith Harbour and Sarah Blankenship.
